**RE: 2013 Public Awareness Program Inspection Tidewater Terminal Company**


*This letter supersedes our previous correspondence dated September 12, 2013 regarding the 2013 Tidewater Public Awareness inspection. Our previous letter incorrectly noted "natural gas" on the subject line and "regulation number" associated with this inspection.*

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Staff (staff) conducted a Public Awareness Program inspection of Tidewater Terminal Company (Tidewater) on August 26, 2013. The inspection included a review of Tidewater's new Public Awareness Program.

Based on this review, staff concludes that the new program meets 49 CFR 195 Public Awareness Program requirements. These requirements will require time to allow the impact of recent program activities to be evaluated. The effectiveness' evaluation is expected to be completed in the 4<sup>th</sup> quarter of 2013. Early in 2014 a follow-up audit will be performed to ensure that Section 4 (effectiveness evaluation) of Tidewater's Public Awareness Program comply with pipeline safety regulations.
