GARBAGE AND REFUSE COLLECTION SERVICE in portions of Clark, Cowlitz and Skamania Counties bounded as follows: Beginning at the intersection of the east line of Section 36, T. 6N., R.3.E. and the south shoreline of the Lewis River; thence following the south bank of said river and Lake Merwin to the intersection of the east line of Section 10, T. 5 N., R. 1 E.; thence south on the east line of the said section to the southeast corner of Section 22, T. 5N., R. 1.E.; thence west on the south line of said section to the northeast corner of Section 29, T. 5 N., R. 1 E.; thence south on the east line of said section to the southeast corner of said section; thence west on the south line of said section projected to the Lewis River; thence following the Lewis River in a generally westerly direction to the intersection of it with the Columbia River; thence following the east bank of the Columbia River in a southerly direction to the intersection of County Road No. 15 extended; thence east on County Road No 15, SSH-1T, William Blank Road and County Road No. 19 to the point of intersection with PSH-1 (U.S. 99); thence south on said highway to County Road No. 8 (NE 179th St); thence east on said road to Manor Highway (NE 72nd Ave); thence south on said highway to County Road No. 6 (N.E. 119th St); thence east on said road projected to the southeast corner of Section 25, T. 3 N., R. 4 E.; (the Clark-Skamania County Line) thence north along the east side of said section 25 extended to the northeast corner of Section 13, T. 5 N., R. 4 E.; thence east on the extended north line of said section to the southeast corner of Section 12, T. 5 N., R. 6 E.; thence north on the east line of said section to the northeast corner of Section 24, T. 7 N., R. 6 E.; thence west on the north line of said section to the northwest corner of Section 24, T. 7 N., R. 3 E.; thence south along the west line of said section to the north shoreline of Lake Merwin; thence easterly along the north shoreline of said lake to its intersection with the east line of Section 36, T 6 N, R 3 E; thence south along the east line of said section to the intersection of the south shoreline, the point of beginning.

Application of Rates

ITEM NO.

Unless otherwise provided, the rates herein cover transportation of biohazardous, infectious, contaminated and other related infectious medical wastes, in specialized container, for the permanent disposition of such products as specified on the title pages herein. All rates shall be in addition to:

1. Actual service fees charged for professional evaluation of medical waste streams and packaging requirements as necessary to comply with all applicable regulations.
2. Special clean up (decontamination) time and expense charges which may result from improper packaging or emergency requirements of generators.
3. Box system - A receptacle made of cardboard that is double lined with red plastic bags for protection. At time of collection, boxes are sealed airtight and shipped to the disposal site for incineration of all contents including the box.
4. Tub system - A receptacle made of rigid plastic with a tight fitting lid and is leakproof and puncture resistant. The tub is lined with red plastic bags for protection. At the time of collection, tub is sealed with lid and shipped to disposal site. At the disposal site contents are removed and incinerated. Tub is then cleaned and sanitized and is available for reuse by another customer.

The customer will have the option of using either a box system or a tub system.

Limitation on Service

ITEM NO.

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1. The waste material to be properly managed by Buchmann Sanitary Service, Inc. is biohazardous/infectious waste produced by the generator. Title to all waste shall remain with the generator. The generator represents and warrants that the waste is as described by Buchmann Sanitary Service, Inc. in writing, all of the hazards and risks incident to the handling, storage, and disposal of the waste. Generator agrees to defend, indemnify and hold harmless Buchmann Sanitary Service, Inc. from and against any and all damages, penalties, fines and liabilities resulting from or arising out of any non-disclosure or misrepresentation as to the quality, hazards, risks and dangerous propensities of the waste material.

2. Transporter reserves the right to modify standard box sizes in the future provided cost per gallon equivalent remains the same unless and until conversion cost changes are approved the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission.

Residential Sharps Program

This is a service to provide residential customers safe disposal of sharps container. The charge for this service is \$19.85 per pickup. The collector will provide and deliver an empty sharps container to a location designated by the customer. There is a fee of \$3.25 for the start up and initial delivery of the empty sharps container. This is an on-call, non-routed, appointment only service. Accounts requiring return trips due to the unavailability of material to be collected for reasons within the control of the customer, will be assessed a charge of \$10.00 in addition to the regular charge. The sharps container will be a one gallon plastic container with locking lid, to be furnished by the collector. The collector will remove the full sharps container. The full container will be bagged and will include a written pickup receipt, signed by the collector, designating the pickup of a full sharps container. The collector shall be paid the fee for service at the time of providing the service.
