Note 1: Container sizes offered are 10, 20 and 35 gallons. Credit shall not be given for partially empty containers.

Note 2: Minimum service, one regularly scheduled pickup per month with a minimum charge of \$ 20.00.

Note 3: Compaction of material shall not be allowed. The maximum weight per container shall not exceed the following:

- 10 gallon box - 25 pounds
- 20 gallon box - 35 pounds
- 35 gallon box - 45 pounds

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LSN TC Note 4: A late charge will be added for any account which remains unpaid at the time of the next regular billing in the amount of 1 %, minimum of \$ 1.00.

Definitions

Service:

This is a service to provide residential customers safe disposal of sharps containers. This will be an on-call, non-routed, appointment only service. Following receipt of a request for service, carrier will remove full sharps container by the end of the next business day. No service rendered on Saturdays, Sundays or holidays.

Return Trips:

When the collector is required to make a return trip to pick up material that was unavailable for collection for reasons under the control of the customer, a charge of \$10.00 will be assessed. This charge to be in addition to all other applicable charges.

Fees:

The charge is per pickup/per container. The fee of \$15.00 shall be assessed for each container picked up, whether it is a separate pickup or same day pickup at same location.

Container:

The sharps container shall be furnished by the customer and shall be a puncture resistant container with a closing lid. The capacity shall be no more than 1 gallon.

Billing:

A written pickup receipt designating the date of pickup of a full sharps container and signed by the collector, will be given to the customer at the time of pickup. The collector shall generate a statement for services rendered, at the above described rate, at the end of each month.

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Disposal:

Disposal of said waste will be at an approved and authorized disposal facility.

Notes:

- 1) Estimate avg. mileage between pickup and storage site to be 35 miles.
- 2) Estimate avg. mileage between Storage site and Disposal site to be 500 miles. Disposal costs include transportation costs to disposal facility.
- 3) Pickup costs include truck time and man hours.
- 4) Misc. & Overhead includes containerization and administrative costs with hopefully some profit.
- 5) The Disposal Facility is: RECOMP of Washington in Ferndale, WA.
- 6) Avg. cost of containers is \$ 1.60 each.
- 7) Cost per mile for providing service estimated to be \$2.00-\$2.25.

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
