

Item No. Application of Rates

10

Disposal Charges

Unless otherwise provided, the rates herein cover the pickup and transportation of waste as specified on the title page herein. All rates shall be in addition to applicable disposal charges at waste disposal sites. See Item #90.

Item No. Limitation on Service

20

1. Collector may refuse to pick-up materials from points where, because of the condition of the streets, alleys or roads, it is impracticable to operate vehicles, and may refuse to drive into private property when in his judgement driveways or roads are improperly maintained or without adequate turn arounds or other unsafe conditions.
2. Collector does not warrant pick-up at any particular hour, other than to meet reasonable requirements.
3. Shipper must specify commodity shipped, provide proper containers in accordance with State and Federal laws. Shipper's name must appear on all containers.
4. Any materials offered for collection and disposal which are not in fact what was called for or appeared on the shipping document will be returned to the shipper or will be disposed of in accordance with current laws and all additional charges will be charged back to the shipper, including fines.

Note #1 - Mileage shall be computed from the point carrier's equipment is located at time such equipment departs to commence the movement tendered and shall continue without interruption until its return thereto regardless of any diversions or other changes as may occur enroute. Computation of mileage shall be determined on the basis of the actual route traveled.

Note #2 - These changes provide for one cleaning of the interior of the tank and if additional cleanings are required, a charge of \$120.00 will be assessed for each cleaning.

C. Route Pickup

Resource will offer regular route pickup of LTL quantities of accumulated waste. There will be a stop charge of \$43.50 per pickup.

Item No. LTL Charges

40 (The changes contained herein constitute a change of wording which results in neither an increase or a decrease)

LTL (less than truckload) is defined as quantities less than the volume equal to 40 55 gallon drums tendered from the same shipper the same loading point at the same time

Rates are computed based on round trip mileage from the origin to the destination and return via the most direct route.

Rates are stated in dollars and cents per container.

Item No. Overtime

70

Normal working hours are 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday. When a customer requests service or has an emergency request outside these hours, or on holidays, the applicable rates and charges will be increased as follows:

- A. Scheduled pickups on Saturday or outside normal hours on weekdays: 15%
- B. Scheduled pickups between midnight Saturday and 7:30 a.m. Monday: 25%
- C. Holiday and emergency pickups: 35%

For the purpose of this rule, holidays shall be:

New Year's Day (January 1)	Thanksgiving Day
Washington's Birthday	Day after Thanksgiving
Memorial Day	December 24
Independence Day	Christmas Day
Labor Day

Item No. Excess Empty Mileage

100

Shipments which move to or from points other than carrier's regular terminal, or location or equipment, involving the movement of empty equipment to point of origin or from point of destination to carrier's terminal or other points enroute will be subject to an additional charge of \$1.54 per excess empty mile. Excess mileage is the total mileage of the trip minus 200% of the loaded miles.

Item No. Cancelled Pickup

110

If a pickup is cancelled after a truck has been dispatched, the customer will be charged 80% of the normal rate for distance actually traveled, and all standby time.

Item No. Disposal Rates

120

Rates in this tariff are subject to disposal fees in effect at the disposal or treatment facility at the time the material is offered for pickup.

Item No. Delinquent Accounts

130

A late charge will be added for any account which remains unpaid at the time of the next regular billing in the amount of 1%, minimum \$1.00.

Item No. Spotting Trailers

140

If Resource Recovery agrees to provide a trailer for loading at a customers convenience or for temporary storage the following rates and charges will apply:

Delivery: Actual round trip mileage run by power unit delivering trailer @ \$1.92 per mile. Normal demurrage will apply to power unit if necessary.

Spotting: \$17.80/24 hours or any part thereof for less than 120 hours. Over 120 hours-by contract.

Item No. Returning Customer Property

150 Charges for returning customer pallets, tub-skids and similar equipment, \$48.00/hour.

Time will be taken from the time the truck arrives at the customer's plant on a return trip until the truck returns to its terminal or is dispatched on another run; or from the time the truck leaves its terminal to return the equipment until it returns to its terminal or is dispatched on another run.

Item No Roll-Off Boxes

30 Container rental shall be \$230 per month or fraction thereof.

All roll-off boxes must be lined prior to loading. There shall be a liner charge of \$60 when Resource Recovery provides the liner.

Transportation of the roll-off box to and from customer site to disposal shall be at the rates and charges contained in Item 30 (A).
