NOTICE OF INTERVENTION

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (WUTC), being an interested commission of the State of Washington, and having jurisdiction to regulate the rates and charges for the sale of electricity to consumers within the State of Washington, hereby gives notice of its intervention in the above-entitled docket, pursuant to Rule 214 of the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission's Rules of Practice and Procedure (18 C.F.R. § 385.214 (2008)). The WUTC is a "State Commission" for purposes of 18 C.F.R. § 385.214(2)(a).

The WUTC intervenes primarily because of its interest in:

- Proposed tariff provisions allowing for (a) the voluntary election to become a

 PacifiCorp EIM Participating Resource and for suspension of EIM

 transactions and exit contained under the market contingencies and

 contingency actions, (b) preservation of Network Integration Transmission

 Service, (c) improving reliability, and (d) market monitoring and

 enforcement;
- (2) The role PacifiCorp's EIM tariff design may have on EIM related work of the Northwest Power Pool Members' Market Assessment and Coordination Committee;
- (3) Addressing operational challenges through more efficient economic dispatch of generation resources; and

(4) Assuring that the benefits of PacifiCorp's EIM will exceed the costs.
