PASSENGER SERVICE RULES AND REGULATIONS

PORT TOWNSEND – FRIDAY HARBOR

ADULT FARES: Fares published are adult fares and apply to passenger who have reached or passed their eleventh birthday.

CHILD FARES: Child fares are available to all passengers who are ten years old or less. Infants who are one year old or less and will not occupy a seat (i.e. they are accompanied by an adult) may travel free of charge.

SCHEDULE MAINTENANCE: Service to Friday Harbor can be subject to local weather conditions. Phone 360-385-5288 for current weather and status of scheduled Service. This company makes no guarantee to arrive at or depart from any location at a specific time and is not liable for any delay of any nature.

BAGGAGE RULES AND CHARGES: Hand baggage not exceeding 50 pounds for each adult fare and not exceeding 30 pounds on each child's fare will be carried free. All objects other than bicycles, kayaks and canoes will be considered baggage. Baggage over 10 feet in length will be considered excess weight. Baggage over 20 feet in length is prohibited.

Excess Weight: For baggage weight in excess of the free allowance the charge will be \$20.00 for each additional 50lb's over the free baggage limit.

Bicycles, kayaks and canoes: Passengers wishing to transport this equipment must Arrive thirty minutes prior to departure and have the equipment in a stored configuration Ready for storage aboard the vessel. This company is not responsible for any damage That occurs to equipment of this nature at any time, prior, during the voyage.

ARTICLES OF EXPLOSIVE NATURE ARE NOT ALLOWED

ANIMALS: Pets may be carried but only in pet carriers with the exception of dogs. Dogs must be leashed and will not be allowed in the passenger cabin at any time. The exception would be for sight or hearing impaired passengers and their dogs. These dogs would not be permitted to occupy a seat. There is no charge for an animal assisting sight of hearing impaired passengers.

GROUP FARES: Group fares apply only to groups that have purchased their tickets in advance of the Departure date. Group fare rates will not be applied for parties wishing to depart the day The day of their purchase.

(C) TICKET LIMITATIONS: Tickets are nonrefundable 48 hours prior to departure. Reservations held by credit card Will be charged upon failure to cancel 48 hours ahead. Tickets are nontransferable. Subject to WAC 480-149-060(1)(a) – "Unused tickets will be redeemed at the purchase price. Unused portions of round trip or commutation tickets will be redeemed by charging the regular fare or fares for the portion or portions used and refunding the balance of the purchase price." Note 1: Order 01 issued in Docket TS-100863 serves as the special permission number which exempts Puget Sound Express from the requirements of WAC 480-149-060 relating to the rules for the redemption of unused tickets as specified in WAS 480-149-200

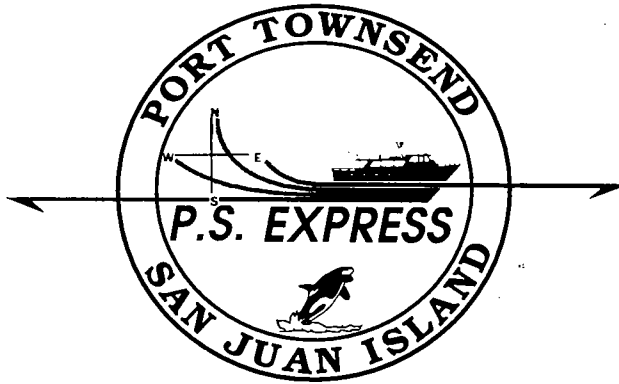

RE: Notice and reason for temporary suspension of service of certificate BC-118

Dear Commission:

I am providing notice that Puget Sound Express was requested by the Washington State Ferries (WSF) to provide emergency foot passenger service between Orcas Island and Shaw Island following the Elwha ferry dock accident at Orcas Island on September 8, 1999.

Will waiting for WSF to determine their needs are normal service was discontinued because of high winds on September 9th and 10th. Following this we commence emergency service on very short notice until WSF could determine their needs. WSF, because of the nature of the situation, could not tell us until until this week how long it might need to use our vessel for this service. At the conclusion of today it will have been it will have been five days since we suspended our normal service for the benefit of the Washington State Ferry situation at Orcas Island

Accordingly, we hereby provide notice under WAC 480-51-140 of our need to temporarily suspend our service until further notice. Any questions regarding this notice should be directed to Peter Hanke, President, Puget Sound Express. Public notices will be posted at our two point of departures.
