**RE: 2014 Natural Gas Public Awareness Follow Up Inspection - Avista Headquarters**

The Utilities and Transportation Staff (staff) with the Oregon Public Utility Commission and the Idaho Public Utilities Commission conducted a Public Awareness Plan (PAP) Inspection of Avista Utilities Corporation (Avista) on May 7 - 8, 2013. Staff concluded at that time that the Avista PAP did not meet the requirements with the exception of the effectiveness evaluation requirements found in Section 4 of API-RP 1162. A subsequent follow up inspection was conducted on March 25, 2014.

Staff found no apparent violations during the follow up PAP inspection.
