- Result Issue Summary Tidewater's manual does not include all required personnel for the random testing pool. They are missing certain personnel who conduct emergency response activities including receiving, identifying and classifying notices of events which need immediate response. This would include supervisors at the Snake River Terminal and dispatchers.
  - Standard Issues B2 (Moderate or small impact/limited occurrence) : 199.105(c) : Process is inadequate to identify all covered employees who must be DOT tested for the presence of prohibited drugs and alcohol.
    - Result Notes Tidewater's process does not include all required personnel in the random testing pool. The random testing pool must include all covered employees as defined in 49 CFR 199.3. The testing pool does not include personnel who conduct emergency response activities including receiving, identifying and classifying notices of events which need immediate response. This would include supervisors at the Snake River Terminal and dispatchers.
