

During the 2021-2023 biennium, the UTC awarded **\$367,538.49** in GCPF grants.

Signal Projects: \$289,966.72 awarded

- CWW LLC: \$65,092.16 to upgrade crossing signal batteries and battery chargers at 13 crossings in the Walla Walla area.
- Washington Eastern Railroad: \$220,000 to upgrade train detection controls and other signal improvements at 11 crossings in Grant, Lincoln, and Spokane Counties.
- Northwest Railway Museum: \$4,874.56 to upgrade signal batteries at the Meadowbrook Road crossing in Snoqualmie.

Non-Signal Projects: \$77,571.77 awarded

- CWW LLC: \$7,375.41 to install warning signs at 43 private crossings in Walla Walla County.
- City of Rainier: \$400 to repaint roadway markings at the Center Street crossing in Rainier.
- Nippon Dynawave Packaging Corporation, LLC: \$10,000 in matching funds to reconstruct a private crossing at Washington Way, Longview.
- Tacoma Rail: \$40,000 toward the purchase of durable chain-link fencing to deter trespassing on its Mountain Division in Tacoma.
- Chehalis-Centralia Railroad and Museum: \$262.60 to purchase Emergency Warning System signs for two pedestrian crossings at its depot in Chehalis.
- South King Fire & Rescue, Federal Way: \$19,533.86 to purchase an aerial drone and weather station to enhance its response to railroad hazardous materials accidents in South King County.
