Outreach Committee Report

Discuss legislation, rulemaking, pipeline safety issues, or upcoming events, for CCOPS to consider in our role of advising federal, state and local agencies on pipeline safety. (UTC/ECY/PST)

General comments:

UTC and ECY reports are provided in written form. Rather than read the entire written report at each meeting, point out and discuss the significant items which CCOPS members should pay attention to. The reports should be sent to CCOPS in advance of meeting, and CCOPS members should read them before the meeting and be ready with questions.

At each meeting, we ask that UTC and ECY keep CCOPS informed of technical resources, upcoming events, and other pipeline issues that UTC and ECY are already tracking on federal, state and local level, such as safety issues related to new trends, safety incidents, rulemaking, or legislation. Provide links to references prior to the meeting. CCOPS will also continue to use Pipeline Safety Trust (PST) as an independent resource for this kind of information.

Other topics of interest may come up during the year. The publicly-posted FAR will be used to give advance notice of agenda items, but that CCOPS may add or reschedule an agenda item, as long as we do that in a way that complies with the open meeting laws, providing sufficient notice of a change in the agenda.
