- (a) Application: Service and supply of water shall be rendered only after the signing of an application by the prospective customer and its acceptance by the utility, such application to state fully and truly all the purposes for which water may be required; and after agreement by the applicant to conform to the lawful rules and regulations established by the utility and filed with the Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (hereinafter referred to as "State Commission").
- (b) Change of Use: The customer will not increase his demand or use of service as stated in his application without giving due notice of such increase. Such a reduction in charge is contingent upon the provisions of the utility's tariff.

(c) Termination of Service: Service will be discontinued upon the customer giving the utility written notice prior to the date of disconnection. 



Rule 15 - Sprinkling and Irrigation

Water used for sprinkling and irrigation shall be paid for at the regular prescribed tariff rates for such service. The hours for such use shall be as prescribed from time to time by the company, subject to protest by any customer affected and to review by the State Commission.

No person shall use water for sprinkling or irrigation purposes during any fire in the area, and all sprinkling and irrigation shall be stopped immediately when an alarm of fire is sounded and not resumed until the fire has been extinguished.

Rule 16 - Property on Public Highways

All distribution mains and those portions of service connections, exclusive of customer owned lines, in or on streets or public highways will be considered utility property and will be maintained by the company at its expense.

Rule 17 - General

All special cases not covered by the foregoing Rules and Regulations will be covered by special rules to be filed as a part of the company's tariff on file with the State Commission, subject in each case to protest according to law.

The company hereby adopts and makes a part of this tariff the regulations of the State Commission as provided in Chapter 480-110, Washington Administrative Code, as amended June 30, 1976.





Continuation of 2023 Disconnection of water service during extreme heat

- (a) A repayment plan required under this section will be designed to pay the past due balance by the following May 15th or as soon as possible after May 15th, to maintain monthly payments that are no greater than six percent of the customer's monthly income, and to pay for continued utility service.
- (b) The repayment plan must not require monthly payments more than six percent of the customer's monthly income. Nothing prohibits the customer from paying more than six percent if the customer chooses to do so.
- (c) A customer will not be considered in default of the repayment plan unless payment during this period is less than six percent of the customer's monthly income. (d) If assistance payments are received by the customer after implementation of the repayment plan, the customer must contact the company to recalculate the repayment plan.
